Hey guys, please....

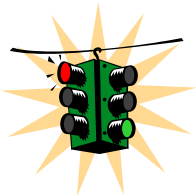


- Remember to show consideration for others. I'm sure you're grateful when others show consideration for you too.

- Please check the rooms before departing and make sure that nothing is missing or gets left behind and that the rooms are clean. If anything is faulty, please let an organiser know.
- The competition organisers are making every effort to ensure that the competition goes smoothly. However, things can occasionally go wrong. Be patient and show understanding. Please remember that the organisers' hair has been rapidly turning grey!
